

Ingot is generally made of metal, either pure or alloy, heated past its melting point and cast into a bar or block. It has been cast into a size and shape (such as a bar) that is convenient to store, transport and work into a semi-finished or finished product.

Continuous casting is the most efficient way to solidify large volumes of metal into simple shapes with consistent quality. The microstructure of the continues cast ingot is even compared to casting ingot in conventional moulds. There is less possibility for arising of tension in the product and the finished parts made with continues cast ingot will be more durable.





Advantages of the continuous cast Ingots over normal Ingots are as follows:

- Faster machining speeds for improved productivity
- Longer tool life
- Better surface finish
- Compact, lead-free chips
- No directionality of mechanical properties
- Close tolerances with complex cast parts
